The Bridgewater Fire Department (BFD) was formed in 1876 by a small group of volunteers wishing to provide fire service for the community. Today, we still provide the Town of Bridgewater with fire protection and education services. With a fleet that includes three pumper trucks, an aerial ladder, a rescue boat, a heavy rescue vehicle and two utility vehicles, the BFD responds to over 200 calls per year, ranging from alarms to structure fires, from gas spills to vehicle fires.

The BFD is one of the larger fire departments in the county with an active membership of approximately 50 members from various employment backgrounds. We have carpenters, mechanics, electricians, office personnel, shift/production workers and retail personnel, among others.

Every firefighter in the BFD, including the Chief, is an unpaid volunteer. We are highly trained firefighters dedicated to the health, safety and the welfare of the people of Bridgewater. To keep skills sharp, we have ongoing training as well as weekly and monthly drills.

As a Junior firefighter, you will be part of a team that will watch out for your safety at all times. Except for live fires and attendance at daily fire calls, you will be expected to perform all the duties of a regular firefighter.
